

# OUR 2016 REVIEW



## **Executive Summary**

ChiYoWo Empowerment Initiative, is a non-governmental organization established and registered in 2016 with the Corporate Affairs Commission in Nigeria. *ChiYoWo is an acronym for Children, Youth and Women*. As part of our mission, we strive to reposition the mindsets of our target audience towards sustained livelihoods especially displaced persons, those in host communities and schools. During 2016, our activities cut across Child Protection and Safety (including Health Awareness Programmes), Environmental Vulnerability workshops, Education and Creativity, Youth4Growth Skills Acquisition training as empowerment tools and nurturing women with specific seed programmes to develop themselves with entrepreneur skills. We pride ourselves on designing and implementing development initiatives to address and remove barriers, which prevent sustainable livelihoods among the most vulnerable people in Nigeria and on the African continent.

One of the fundamental objectives of ChiYoWo, is to provide harmonious living amongst Nigerians through promoting and protecting their fundamental human rights especially when it comes to the provision of basic needs. This aim is reflective in the Constitutive Act of the African Union, Article 3(h). It is further echoed in the Convention for the Protection and Assistance of Internally Displaced Persons in Africa (Kampala Convention), where the African legal framework seeks to *a) prevent internal displacement, b) protect and assist people during displacement and c) provide durable solutions for displaced people.* Nevertheless, societal challenges continue to give us reason to design new intervention programmes. These constantly revolving activities are further guided by the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), The Universal Declaration of Human Rights, Convention on the Rights of the Child, Nigeria Vision 2020 Plan and Nigeria Youth Empowerment Plan.

ChiYoWo Empowerment Initiative is fully aware displacement occurs as a result of a myriad of factors such as, conflict, violence, economic migration and environmental factors. To this end, ChiYoWo continually provides a crucial role as a civil society organization (CSO) in providing protection and assistance by way of relief, educational programmes, water and sanitation hygiene (WASH), and basic needs to the needy.

#### Over view: Year 2016

Some of the highlights of the year include celebrating **Children's Day**. The event held simultaneously in Lagos State and Abuja, Federal Capital Territory. Through the themed Project titled: **Our Children Our Future**, over 300 children were empowered to become Transformation Ambassadors in the society at community levels. ChiYoWo also joined the world in commemorating the **International Day of the Girl Child themed Girls' Progress: What Counts for Girls** in Benin, where over 70 girls were empowered.



In the course of implementing our humanitarian projects in northern Nigeria, ChiYoWo trained 60 women in bead making, repaired a Hand Held Water Pump Borehole and donated educational and relief materials to families in Durumi Internally Displaced Persons Camp, Abuja. ChiYoWo also celebrated the *United Nations Global Hand Washing Day* at the Durumi Camp. Children and women were given soap and informed of the benefits of water, sanitation and hygiene practices through a workshop. They were encouraged to '*Make Hand Washing a Habit*'.

Youth were not left out. ChiYoWo Empowerment initiative actively engaged youth using social media platforms such as Facebook and Twitter to inspire them become future World Leaders in commemoration of the *International Youth Day*. The live twitter question and answer session was titled "*The Road to 2030: Eradicating Poverty and Achieving Sustainable Production and Consumption*". This is in line with our drive towards the attainment of the SDGs by 2030.

Our tireless work gained the attention of the British Broadcasting Corporation's (BBC) flagship programme, *Focus in Africa*. We were interviewed by the BBC and gave a tour of Durumi Internally Displaced Persons Camp, in Abuja.

As a round up for the year 2016, ChiYoWo partnered with the Society for Peace Studies and Practice and visited our target beneficiaries in the IDP Camp. This collaborative engagement led to the delivery of food, clothes and educational material for children, youth and women – the most vulnerable people in our community.

In my role as the Executive Director and Founder, my sincere gratitude goes to our Patron, Trustees, Advisory Committee, Volunteers, Partners and Supporters who, through their tireless effort and care, made a huge difference in our work in 2016. ChiYoWo will continue to initiate and implement intervention programmes geared towards uplifting the social, economic, technological and environmental status of all Nigerians through sustained collaborations with Government, Private Sector, NGOs / Civil Society Organizations and individual philanthropists.




